Australian Open Qualifying - Wednesday, January 14 (it's free!)

On Wednesday, January 14, the TOTAL TENNIS team are going to the Australian Open qualifying tournament. Everyone is welcome to come along.

We will be catching the 10.18am bus from Deer Park Railway Station / Tilburn Rd to then catch the train at 10.44am at Sunshine Railway Station (platform 1). We will return to Deer Park Railway Station at 3.42pm.

Bus / train costs are the normal costs but entry to watch the qualifying tournament is FREE of charge.





NSJTA (junior) competition – starts soon!

The Autumn season (season 1) of junior competition for 2015 starts soon:

- The Friday night competition starts on Friday, January 30
- The Saturday morning competition starts on Saturday, January 31

We have 6 teams this season – 1 on Friday night (A Grade 3), 5 on Saturday morning (all other grades).

The meeting to pickup fixtures, meet teammates, etc. will be on Tuesday, January 27.

- The men's competition starts on Thursday, February 5
